


Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament






The Solemnity of The Ascension of the Lord Thursday 30th May 2019 is the Solemnity of The Ascension of the Lord. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. Holy Mass will be celebrated at

6.30am, **9.15am** and **7.30pm**.

The Ascension, which marks the final departure of Christ from his friends on earth, celebrates hope in our future. It proclaims that Jesus, who spent his life in Jerusalem and the surrounding countryside, achieved the work he was sent to do and is now in heaven in the company of God the Father, beyond the boundaries of death and decay. Where Christ has gone we hope to follow, once our earthly journey is over.

Novena to the Holy Spirit

The Novena to the Holy Spirit begins on **Friday 31st May** for **9** days finishing on Saturday 1st June, the day before Pentecost. The Novena in honour of the Holy Spirit is the oldest of all Novenas since it was first made at the direction of Our Lord Himself when He sent His Apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit on the first Pentecost.

First Saturday Devotion

First Saturday Devotion takes place every First Saturday morning with Exposition at 8.15am followed by Mass at 9.15am.

The Devotion consists of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, receiving Holy Communion, reciting a decade of the Rosary and a 15 minute meditation in the company of Our Lady.

The First Saturday Devotion (also called the Act of Reparation to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary), according to Lúcia of Fátima, was requested by the Virgin Mary in an apparition at Pontevedra, Spain in December 1925.
