The Great and Holy Week:

This week we enter the Great and Holy Week, and journey with Our Lord Jesus Christ from His triumphal entry into Jerusalem, to joyful cries of the Pilgrims from the North: **“Hosanna to the Son of David!”** Later, on Friday, the **“Judeans”** from the south around Jerusalem, (in John’s Gospel called **“the Jews”**) will call out **“Crucify Him!”**

His Death and Rising from the Tomb, with His Return to the Father in the Ascension, is the great Easter, or Paschal, Mystery.

Joining Him in our Prayer and Pences, we pray for an end to the Corona Virus, supporting all the Key Workers and NHS, and earnestly praying for Conversion of all the Peoples of the World to know, love and serve God in this world to be forever happy with God in heaven,

as we are also looking forward to, and awaiting:

“the Resurrection of the Body, and Life everlasting. Amen.”

On **Good Friday, 10th April 2020**, we can begin **the Novena of the Divine Mercy: F.I.N.C.H.**

- F:** **Feast of Divine Mercy** is on Low Sunday, the second Sunday of Easter - **19th April 2020;**
- I:** **Image/Icon of Jesus**, the Divine Mercy, with words **“Jesus, I trust in You!”;**
- N:** **Novena** - Nine days of Prayer with particular intentions for each day, beginning on Good Friday, (10th) ending on Divine Mercy Sunday (19th);
- C:** **Chaplet / Rosary of Divine Mercy** takes 7 to 10 minutes to pray;
- H:** **Hour of Mercy = 3 o’clock**, daily pray the Three o’clock Prayer, especially on Fridays.
