Confessions may be heard by appointment, on request. Please 'phone or Email to arrange a reasonable time.

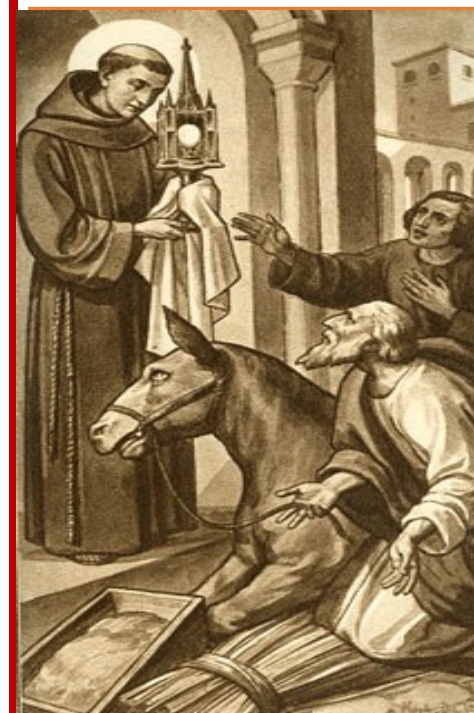

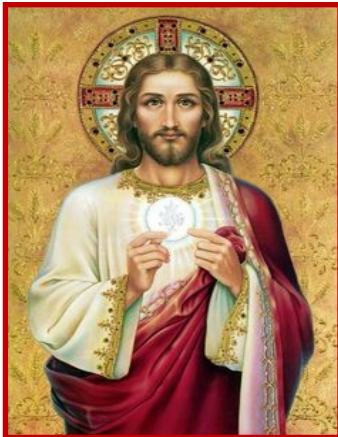

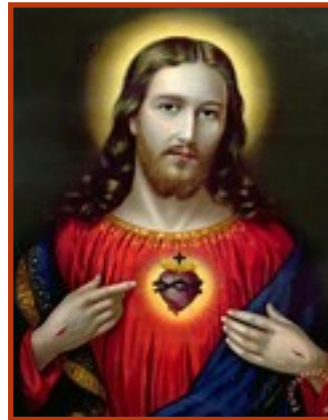

THE FIRST SMALL STEPS FOR A SAFE RE-OPENING OF ST MARY'S CHURCH FOR PRIVATE AND PERSONAL PRAYER INITIALLY, i.e.: **NOT Holy Mass yet:**

- 1: Protecting those at higher risk;**
 - 2: Enhanced cleaning of the Church;**
 - 3: Social Distancing;**
 - 4: Face covering;**
 - 5: Hygiene - hand washing and sanitizing;**
- We will need to submit a Risk Assessment to ensure we can open and keep clean the Church safely, with **"A TEAM OF STEWARDS"**, or **Two, (of four persons perhaps?)** in place to ensure we can manage well for a few hours a day, even a couple of days a week ... **Please can you help?**

If approved by the Diocese, the plan is to open for ONE HOUR on Thursday 18th and again on Friday 19th from 09:30 to 10:30 both days. For more information, please contact the Parish Office, by Email or 'phone.
