June is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

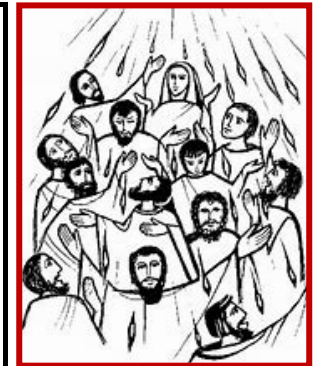
The devotion to the **Sacred Heart** (also known as **the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**, *Sacratissimum Cor Iesu* in Latin) is one of the most widely practiced and well-known Catholic devotions wherein the heart of Jesus is viewed as a symbol of "God's boundless and passionate love for mankind"

Sacred Heart of Jesus Prayer

O most Holy Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore You, I love You, and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer You this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to Your will. Grant, Good Jesus, that I may live in You and for You. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, Your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen.

Pentecost Sunday

In Acts 2:1-41 the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles. This occurred ten days after Jesus' Ascension. Jesus had asked his Apostles to pray, and their nine days of prayer can be considered as the first novena. When the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles, they preached the Good News of Jesus Christ. Miraculously, people of many different languages and nations could understand the Apostles in their own languages. This miracle reflected God's desire for the Gospel to be preached to all, and for all the peoples of the earth to be united in faith.



Sunday 31st May would usually be **THE FEAST OF THE VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY** to her Cousin Elizabeth who is in her sixth month of expecting her baby: **John the Baptist**. Both expectant Mothers to be are overwhelmed by **the Holy Spirit**. Elizabeth gives us the second line of the **"HAIL MARY"**:
"Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb!" (Luke 1:42). And **Mary, as a Prophet** proclaims **THE MAGNIFICAT** - **the glorious doings and workings of God!! (Luke 1:46-55)** The whole mysterious moment is **an outpouring of God's Holy Spirit** - from the **Unborn Christ Child** to the **Unborn John** to Elizabeth and then also to **Mary: THE SECOND JOYFUL MYSTERY OF THE HOLY ROSARY.**
