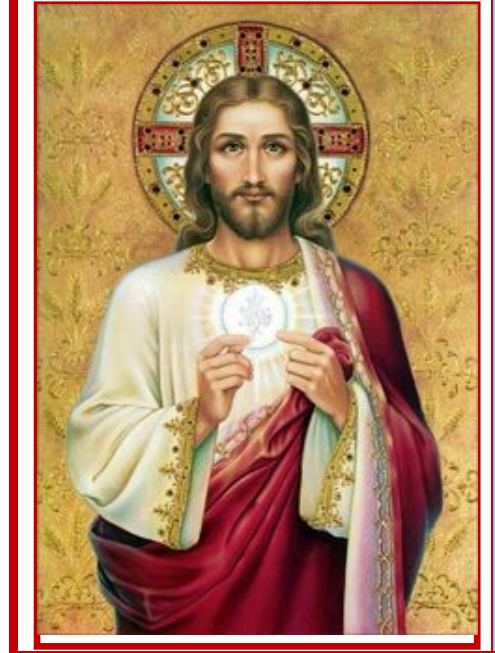
Through our life in Christ we live the life of the Trinity. God is a perfect community and if we model our lives on the Trinity then the God of love and peace will be with us.
