adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus) because it is united to her person
and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue and inner life.

ST MARY'S **SUMMER HOLIDAY** **SPIRITUAL "WORKOUT"**

For a healing, to become healthy,
whole, and holy in
Body, Mind, Soul and Spirit:

- 1: Daily** [Family] **Holy Rosary**
(at least 5 decades/mysteries);
 - 2: Daily Family Reading and Praying**
the Holy Bible: start with the four
Gospels ... **in order to know, to love**
and to serve Our Lord Jesus;
 - 3: Daily Holy Mass** and
Holy Communion whenever and
wherever possible;
 - 4: Fasting on Bread and Water**
(or some other kind of Penance)
twice a week (for those who can)
on Wednesdays
- in remembrance
of Judas' Betrayal and
on Fridays
- in remembrance of
Christ's self Sacrifice on
the Cross on Calvary;
 - 5: Monthly Confession** of all one's
sins, (mortal/serious/grave and) venial:
*"It will be a Remedy
for the West!"*
