First Holy Communion 2020

As you know so much has been disrupted and been put on hold this year, The Celebration of First Holy Communion, or, the Reception of Our Lord, "Hidden Jesus" in Holy Communion for the First Time has been no exception. "Life cycle Ceremonies", according to **current Guidance allows only 6 persons to attend**, we have therefore decided to have our children Receive Our Lord for the First Time during a usual Sunday, or Weekday, Holy Mass when we may accommodate up to **44 "Bubbles" Households etc.** Over the next few weeks the Children who have been prepared since September 2019 until the March Lockdown 2020, will be Receiving Our Lord in ones, twos or threes at Sunday or Weekday Holy Mass, rather than one big "event" it means that the Parish Family of St Mary's will be able to witness, and pray seriously for the children and their families, and indeed also be their Families on behalf of those who cannot travel or be present for the joyful Reception of Our Lord in Holy Communion.

THE ROSARY IN OCTOBER:

"Those who recite five decades of the Rosary in church, or as a family, a religious community, or as a group of the faithful, may gain a plenary indulgence daily; in other circumstances a partial indulgence. A partial indulgence may be obtained daily by reciting the Litany of Loreto and the Prayer to Saint Joseph. The practice of reciting the Rosary should be explained and commended."
