### **EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES**

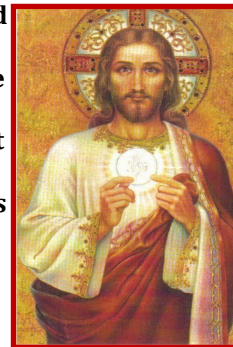
