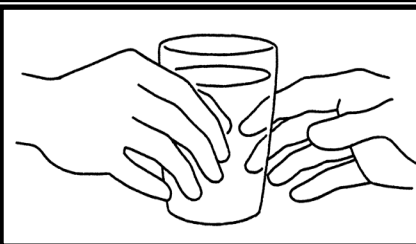

**TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME (B)**

The Apostles were anything but pleased when they witnessed an outsider casting out demons **in the name of Jesus**. They resented his intrusion, were jealous and felt threatened, because he was doing their work and yet was not part of their group. He had no right to be using **THE NAME OF THE SAVIOUR**, so John made a complaint in the hope of having this unlicensed preacher silenced. John must have been surprised that Jesus refused to stop the man from doing good work **IN HIS NAME**. Jesus made it clear that all good comes from God the Father and that doing charitable work was not the exclusive right of His followers. God moves where He wills and chooses whom He wills. His Spirit is at work beyond the confines of established religion.
