(24th April);
- C: Chaplet/Rosary of
Divine Mercy** takes
7 to 10 minutes to pray;
- H: Hour of Mercy**
is **3 o'clock**, daily pray
the Three o'clock Prayer,
especially on Fridays.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY
SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER
24TH APRIL 2022

In her *Diary*, St. Faustina records a special promise given to her by Jesus. He told her to communicate it to the whole world:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy (699).

In three places in her *Diary*, St. Faustina records our Lord's promises of specific, extraordinary graces:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109).


Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (300).

The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (699).

To receive these graces, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good "confession beforehand" and staying in the state of grace" and "trusting in His Divine Mercy".

By these conditions, our Lord is emphasizing the value of confession and Holy Communion as miracles of mercy. The Eucharist is Jesus, Himself, the Living God, pours Himself as Mercy into our hearts.

SAINT FAUSTINA KOWALSKA:



THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

can be said on ordinary Rosary beads:

*first say, one "Our Father,"
one "Hail Mary,"
and the "I believe in God..."*

Then on the single, large beads say the following words:

"Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and the sins of the whole world."

On the smaller (ten / decade) beads, you say the following words:

"For the sake of His Sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world."

After the five decades, you say these words three times:

"Holy God! Holy Mighty One! Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world!"
(diary 476)

.....
*3 o'clock in the afternoon is the **HOURLY of MERCY**, the Hour at which the Saviour of the World, hanging upon the Cross, on Good Friday, died. He gave up His Spirit, and His side was pierced, His Heart broken open by the Centurion with the spear. From His side came out Blood and Water – an Ocean of Mercy* ...

The "THREE O'CLOCK PRAYER:

"You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us." *(diary 1319)*

"O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us, I trust in You." *(diary 84)*

Say this last part three times.

OPTIONAL CLOSING PRAYER:

Eternal God, in Whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, hat in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy Will, which is love and Mercy itself.
(diary 950)
