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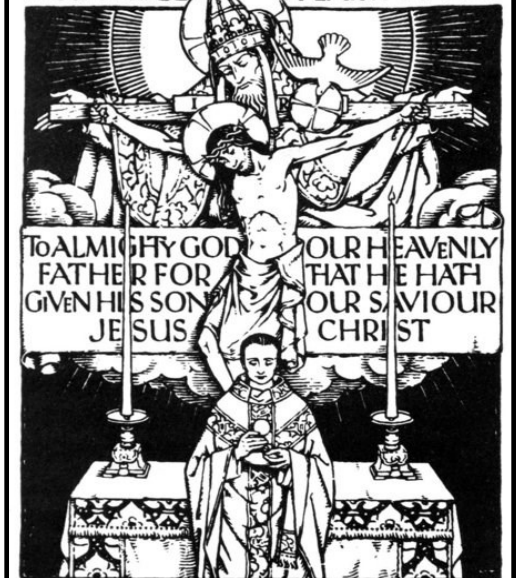

The Martyrs' Picture
by Durante Alberti (1583)
hangs over the sanctuary in the
Venerable English College Church of
THE MOST HOLY TRINITY and
ST THOMAS BECKET in The City of Rome.

The Martyrs: St Thomas Becket, Arch-
bishop of Canterbury (A.D. 1118 - 1170)
martyred on the whim of King Henry
II (for which, by the way, LESNES AB-
BEY was founded in reparation for the
King's sin), and St Edmund, King of
East Anglia (A.D. 841 - 869) killed by
Vikings, BOTH KNEEL BEFORE The Cru-
cified Body of Christ presented to us
by God the Father. The Holy Spirit,
like a Dove, hovers between Them.

THE MOST PRECIOUS BODY, BLOOD,
SOUL AND DIVINITY
OF JESUS CHRIST,
PRESENT
IN ALL THE TABERNACLES
of the world,
in reparation for
the outrages,
sacrileges and indifference
with which He Himself is offended.
And through the infinite merits of
HIS MOST SACRED HEART,
and
THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY,
I beg of You the conversion
of the poor sinners.
AMEN.
*(Angel of Peace, Autumn 1916)***



In the picture below, the three little Children Worship and Adore the Most Holy Eucharist, the Blessed Sacrament, that the Angel has brought to them at Valinhos. Lucia, who had "made her First Holy Communion". Francisco and Jacinta, both of whom had not yet "made their First Holy Communion" received The Precious Blood from the drops that fell from the Sacred Host into the Chalice.

With their heads touching the ground they recited frequently the Angel's Second Prayer.

*(Our Lady of Fatima 13th July 1917)***

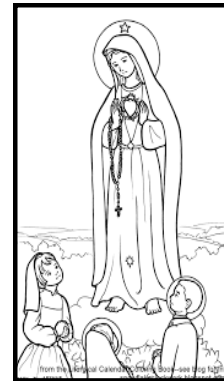
THE FATIMA "DECADE" PRAYER

*(say at the end of each
DECADE of the Rosary.):*

**"O MY JESUS, forgive us our sins,
save us from the fires of hell.
Lead all souls to heaven, especially
those most in need of Your mercy."
*(Our Lady of Fatima 13th July 1917)***

Our Mother Mary shows the Children her Immaculate Heart surrounded by thorns while she asks them to pray for the conversion of sinners, and to make sacrifices for sinners and to pray the Holy Rosary everyday for Peace in the world ...

at that time the Great War, World War I of 1914-1918 was still raging.



RETURNING TO MASS AT PENTECOST
5th June 2022

THE REINSTATEMENT OF
THE OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS
5TH JUNE 2022

From the 18th March 2020 through to the 5th June 2022 the Bishops of England and Wales suspended the obligation to attend Holy Mass in England and Wales. **As of the 5th June 2022, Pentecost, the Bishops will lift the suspension of the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.** Parents applying for a place at St Joseph's, under a faith based criteria will need to complete a Supplementary Information Form. **Evidence of practice will be measured by frequency of attendance at Holy Mass as validated by either a priest or minister,** as was the case prior to 18th March 2020. These arrangements apply to the admissions round for 2023 and subsequent rounds.
