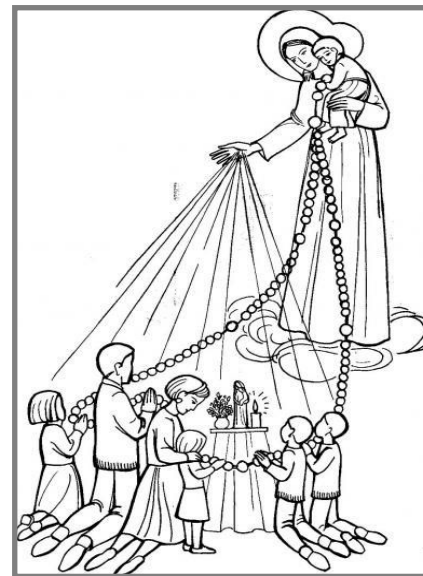
*From our Archbishop, John Wilson, in this Month of October of the Holy Rosary of Mary:*

there kneel down at Mass for me.

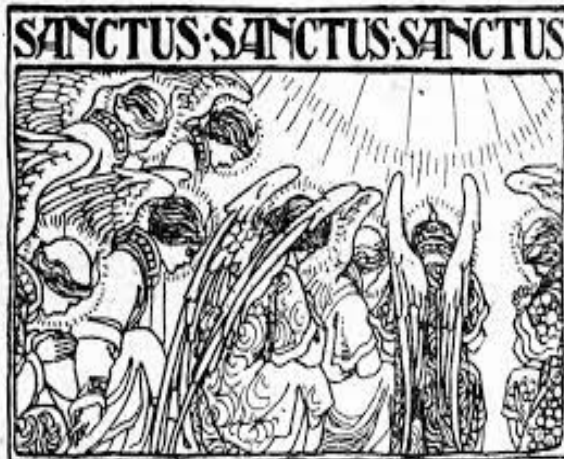
**At the Offertory**, take me to God,
