THE ANGELUS

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Marv.

R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

HAIL MARY, full of grace, The Lord is with Thee: Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, **IESUS.**

HOLY MARY, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen

V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord. R. Be it done unto me according to thy word. HAIL MARY...

(please kneel or bow for the next verse) V. And the Word was made flesh. R. AND DWELT AMONG US. HAIL MARY...

V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God. R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray:

Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts, that we to whom the Incarnation of Christ Thy Son was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and

CHRIST THE KING AND YOU:

Before King Charles was crowned King he was anointed as the LORD's ANOINTED. So solemn was this that it took place behind screens and was not seen by others even in Westminster Abbev. The anointing was possibly more sacred than the Crowning itself.

When you were Baptised, you were 'Christened' Anointed twice: once before and again after Baptism. Before with the Oil of Catechu- Do you see, and do you now know, yet-Christians', and afterwards given to you at your Baptism / with the Sacred Oil of Chrism,

and you were Anointed, that is: 'CHRIST-ED'. AS PRIEST, PROPHET AND KING!

Before Baptism, on your breast, and at Infant Baptism before 1969, also on your shoulders to prepare and strengthen you.

After Baptism, on the Crown of your head - you were 'crowned'!

OIL OF CATECHUMENS: PRE-BAPTISMAL ANOINTING: After 1969:

"We anoint you with oil of salvation in the name of Christ our Saviour; May He strengthen you with His power Who lives and reigns for ever and ever. R/: Amen.

He anoints the child on the breast with the oil of catechumens."

After the Baptism, that is: the pouring of the water and invocation of the Most Holy Trinity: The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit:

OIL OF SACRED CHRISM POST-BAPTISMAL ANOINTING: After 1969:

"The God of power and the Father

of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed vou from sin and brought vou to new life through water and the Holy Spirit.

He now anoints you with the chrism of salvation, so that, united with His people, so you may remain forever a member of Christ Who is PRIEST, PROPHET and KING. R/: Amen.

Next, the celebrant anoints the child on the crown of the head with chrism, in

> **CUI SERVIRE.EST REGNARE!** (TO SERVE IS TO REIGN! also, to reign is to serve!)

LORD JESUS. BE THE KING OF MY LIFE AND EVERYONE AND EVERYTHING I LOVE. REIGN IN MY FAMILY AND IN OUR HOME TOGETHER. DIRECT AND RULE EVERYONE OF MY ACTIONS AND EVERYONE OF MY THOUGHTS. MAY GOD'S WILL BE DONE IN ME AND IN ALL HIS CREATURES, ON EARTH, AS IT IS IN HEAVEN!
