Indulgences" from Gift of the Indulgence summarizes the usual conditions required); given in the Church's law (cf. Apostolic Penitentiary, Prot. N. 39/05/I):

- 1. This is how an indulgence is defined in the Code of Canon Law (can. 992) and in the Catechism of the Cathgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints".

- 4. A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace:
