

Our Lady, Mary, the Mother of God, appeared to a novice of the Daughters of Charity, Catherine Laboure on 18th July 1830. Later Mother Mary asked her to have a medal made to remind people of the love and protection Our Lady offer us. Wearing the medal is a gesture of our acceptance. The medal is shown above: "O MARY CONCEIVED

WITHOUT SIN PRAY FOR US WHO HAVE RECOURSE TO THEE." Our Lady stands upon the globe, the world crushing the head of the serpent that tempted Eve in the garden of Eden. It is a struggle between good and evil. The light and grace of Christ flows from her hands. On the reverse of the medal a large 'M' is surmounted by a Cross. Mary was at the foot of her Son's Cross on Calvary. She became the Mother of the people of God, founded on the twelve Apostles, the twelve stars around the side. The two hearts show the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, pierced with a sword.

In 1854 Pope Pius IX formally defined the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

In 1858, Our Lady appeared to 14 year old Bernadette Soubirous in Lourdes 18 times and confirmed the Pope's declaration with the words: "I AM THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION" on the 25th March.
