THE SEASON OF ADVENT

'Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight.

'During Advent the playing of the organ and other musical instruments, as well as floral decoration of the altar, should be marked by a moderation that reflects the character of the season, but does not anticipate the full joy of Christmas.

'Advent is a season apt for reflecting on Mary, the Mother of God in the role in our redemption. Traditionally, the Anthem 'Alma Redemptoris Mater' is sung after Compline until 1st February.

'The new lectionary cycle for Sundays begins, that is (B), the year of Mark. [...] 'The Gloria ...' is not said in seasonal Masses in Advent.'
