#### SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER (B)

On the evening of the first day of the week, when the Lord Jesus appeared to the apostles while they were at prayer in the upper room, Thomas was not there. The others tried to convince him, as best they could, that they had seen the Lord, but his continued reaction was to doubt. Good Friday and the death of Jesus on the hill of Calvary had crushed Thomas' dream of a lifetime, and left him deeply wounded and disillusioned. He would not easily trust again with clear proof. "Unless I see the holes that the nails have made in His hands and can put my hand into His side, I refuse to believe."

Thomas stands for all of us who travel the road of doubt and at times are unsure of our belief. The loud doubts he echoes in the Gospel lurk in all of us. Jesus respected Thomas' honesty and met him at the very point of his uncertainty. He understood fully his situation as he does ours in our moments of crisis and despair.
