PENTECOST (B)

Over the past seven weeks since Easter we have been celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ, and recalling His many appearances on the apostles. As they recognised His presence, their hearts burned within them and they were filled with comfort, reassurance, inner peace and strength.

Today is the Feast of Pentecost which recalls the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles in the form of a roaring wind and tongues of fire.

Suddenly there was no longer uncertainty, everything fell into place and made sense and at that moment the Church was born.

The coming of the Spirit on that first day of Pentecost was not a once and for all event, but the beginning of His permanent presence in the Church. 
