IT is the saying of holy men that, **LIKE THE BOY SHEPHERD, DAVID**, if we wish to be perfect, we have nothing more to do than to perform the ordinary duties of the tion - short, not because easy, but because pertinent and intelligible. There are no short ways to perfection, but there are sure ones.

Linsist on this because I think it. will simplify our views, and fix our exertions on a definite aim. If you ask me what you are to do in order to be perfect, I say, first –

- Do not lie in bed beyond the due time of rising;
- give your first thoughts to God:
- make a good visit to the **Blessed Sacrament:**
- say the Angelus devoutly;
- eat and drink to God's glory;
- say the Rosary well;
- be recollected:
- keep out bad thoughts;
- make your

evening meditation well:

- examine yourself daily;
- go to bed in good time, and -

YOU ARE ALREADY PERFECT.
